FENTANYL IN TENNESSEE

Deaths from fentanyl increased by **302**% between 2017 and 2020.

Fentanyl was responsible for **16.8 deaths** per **100,000 Tennesseans** in 2019.

In 2019, **2,089** individuals in Tennessee died of a drug overdose with **1,087** of those deaths caused by Fentanyl.



FENTANYL IN AMERICA

In 2019, synthetic-opioid overdoses were **11 times higher** than they were in 2013.

In 2019 alone, **70,630 people died** from drug overdoses.

FENTANYL IN TENNESSEE

Deaths from fentanyl increased by 446% between 2017 and 2021.

Fentanyl was responsible for 38.7 deaths per 100,000 Tennesseans in 2021.

In 2021, <u>3,814</u> individuals in Tennessee died of a drug overdose with <u>2,734</u> of those deaths caused by Fentanyl.



FENTANYL IN AMERICA

In 2021, synthetic-opioid overdoses were **22 times higher** than they were in 2013.

In 2021 alone, <u>106,699 people died</u> from drug overdoses.
